Highway Location: CHESHIRE
Authority In Control: TOWN OF CHESHIRE
Name of Highway: Lanesborough Road

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Cheshire

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

LANESBOROUGH ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Lanesborough Town line,
Thence northerly on Lanesborough Road
1.88 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Route 8;
the total distance being 1.88 miles.

LANESBOROUGH ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Route 8,
Thence southerly on Lanesborough Road
1.88 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the
Lanesborough Town line, the total distance being 1.88 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
