Highway Location: BREWSTER  
 Authority in Control: TOWN OF BREWSTER  
 Name of Highway(s): Route 39

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Brewster

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Route 39 - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Harwich Town Line, thence northerly on Route

1.20 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the Orleans Town Line, the total distance being 1.20 miles.

Route 39 - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Orleans Town Line, thence southerly on Route 39

1.20 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the Harwich Town Line, the total distance being 1.20 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
