SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 669

Highway Location: NORWOOD  
 Authority In Control: TOWN OF NORWOOD  
 Name of Highway(s): Dean Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Norwood

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Dean Street - EASTBOUND

Beginning at Washington Street, thence easterly on Dean Street

0.39 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.90 " " 30 " " " ending at

Neponset Street; the total distance being 1.29 miles.

Dean Street - WESTBOUND

Beginning at Neponset Street, thence westerly on Dean Street

0.90 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.39 " " 25 " " " ending at

Washington Street; the total distance being 1.29 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
