Highway Location: SPENCER
Authority In Control: TOWN OF SPENCER
Name of Highway: CHERRY STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Spencer

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

CHERRY STREET-EASTBOUND

Beginning at Mechanic Street
Thence easterly on Cherry Street
0.77 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Greenville Road; the total distance being 0.77 miles.

CHERRY STREET-WESTBOUND

Beginning at Greenville Road
Thence westerly on Cherry Street
0.77 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Mechanic Street; the total distance being 0.77 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
