Highway Location: SOUTHBIDGE  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF SOUTHBIDGE  
Name of Highway: SOUTH STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Town Manager  
of the Town of Southbridge

Special Speed Regulation number 703, dated April 13, 1972 is hereby amended by striking out the Regulation in its intirety and inserting in place thereof the following revisions:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTH STREET-EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Sturbridge - Southbridge Line  
Thence easterly on South Street  
0.85 miles at 40 miles per hour  
0.43 " " 25 " " "  
0.71 " " 30 " " " ending at Main Street;  
the total distance being 1.99 miles.

SOUTH STREET-WESTBOUND

Beginning at Main Street  
Thence westerly on South Street  
0.71 miles at 30 miles per hour  
0.43 " " 25 " " "  
0.85 " " 40 " " " ending at the  
Southbridge - Sturbridge Line; the total distance being 1.99 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
