Highway Location: FALMOUTH
Authority In Control: TOWN OF FALMOUTH
Name of Highway: MARAVISTA AVENUE EXTENSION

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Falmouth

Special Speed Regulation number 705 dated April 13, 1972 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Maravista Avenue Extension and inserting in place thereof the following revision.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

MARAVISTA AVENUE EXTENSION-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Maravista Avenue
Thence northerly 0.35 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.10 " " 25 " " " " ending at Route 28;
the total distance being 0.45 miles.

MARAVISTA AVENUE EXTENSION-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the end of School Zone
Thence southerly 0.25 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Maravista Avenue; the total distance being 0.25 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
