Name of Highway: LYMAN STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Westborough

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

LYMAN STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet north of East Main Street
Thence northerly on Lyman Street
0.49 miles at 30 miles per hour
1.35 " " 40 " " " ending at the Northborough
Town Line; the total distance being 1.84 miles.

LYMAN STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Northborough Town Line
Thence southerly on Lyman Street
1.35 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.52 " " 30 " " " ending at East Main
Street; the total distance being 1.87 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
