In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 7072, dated July 1, 1981 is hereby amended by striking out the Regulation in its entirety and inserting in place of the following revisions and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

EASTBOUND

Beginning in Marlborough at the end of Interstate 290 (Station 0+00) thence easterly

- 0.98 miles at 50 miles per hour
- 0.01 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Hudson Town Line thence easterly in Hudson. $\[\]$
- 0.54 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the junction of Route 85 (Washington Street); the total distance being 1.53 miles.

WESTBOUND

Beginning at a point 200' west of the junction of Route 85 (Washington Street) thence westerly

- 0.41 miles at 40 miles per hour
- 1.08 miles at 50 miles per hour ending at the junction of I-290; the total distance being 1.49 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).

The Highway Department and the Registry of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
