In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 7080, dated October 2, 1981 is hereby amended by striking out the Regulation in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following revision and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

FRONTAGE ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 350 feet north of the junction of Ararat Street
Thence northerly on Frontage Road
0.62 miles at 50 miles per hour
0.10 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of West Mountain Street;
the total distance being 0.72 miles.

FRONTAGE ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 250 feet south of the junction of West Mountain Street
Thence southerly on Frontage Road
0.82 miles at 45 miles per hour ending at the junction of Ararat Street; the total
distance being 0.82 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
