That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

## ROUTE 123 - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Easton Town Line

Thence westerly on Route 123

1.23 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the beginning of State Highway east of Route I-495.

And beginning again at the end of State Highway west of Route I-495.

0.44 miles at 35 miles per hour 0.89 " " 40 " " "

0.24 " " 30. " " ending at the beginning of State Highway east of Route 140; the total distance being 2.80 miles.

## ROUTE 123 - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the end of State Highway east of Route 140 Thence easterly on Route 123

0.24 miles at 30 miles per hour 0.89 " " 40 " " "

0.89 " " 40 " " " o.44 " " 35 " " ending at the beginning of State Highway, west of Route I-495

And beginning again at the end of State Highway east of Route I-495 1.23 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the Easton Town Line; the total distance being 2.80 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
