In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
 by the Board of Selectmen
 of the Town of Rutland

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

PLEASANT DALE ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Paxton Town Line
 Thence northerly on Pleasant Dale Road

0.92 miles	at	45 miles per hour			
0.86	"	40	"	"	"
0.24	"	25	"	"	"
0.48	"	30	"	"	"
1.20	"	40	"	"	"
0.09	"	25	"	"	"

ending at (Route 122-A); the total distance being 3.79 miles.

PLEASANT DALE ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 350 feet south of Route (122-A)
 Thence southerly on Pleasant Dale Road

1.22 miles	at	40 miles per hour			
0.48	"	30	"	"	"
0.24	"	25	"	"	"
0.86	"	40	"	"	"
0.92	"	45	"	"	"

ending at the Paxton Town Line the total distance being 3.72 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.
