Name of Highway: HIGH STREET-POND STREET
HALL STREET-LOWELL STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Dunstable

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

HIGH STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 110 feet north of Route 113
Thence northerly on High Street
1.93 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Nashua,
New Hampshire Town Line; the total distance being 1.93 miles.

HIGH STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Nashua, New Hampshire Town Line
Thence southerly on High Street
1.95 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Route 113;
the total distance being 1.95 miles.

POND STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Tyngsboro Town Line
Thence northerly on Pond Street
1.91 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Route 113;
the total distance being 1.91 miles.

POND STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet from Route 113
Thence southerly on Pond Street
1.88 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the Tyngsboro
Town Line; the total distance being 1.88 miles.

HALL STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Groton Town Line
Thence northerly on Hall Street
1.22 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Groton Street;
the total distance being 1.22 miles.

HALL STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Groton Street
Thence southerly on Hall Street
1.22 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the Groton
Town Line; the total distance being 1.22 miles.

LOWELL STREET-EASTBOUND

Beginning at Route 113
Thence easterly on Lowell Street
1.12 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the Tyngsboro
Town Line; the total distance being 1.12 miles.

LOWELL STREET-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Tyngsboro Town Line
Thence westerly on Lowell Street
1.05 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.07 " " 25 " " ending at Route 113;
the total distance being 1.12 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of
these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater
than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in
any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
