Highway Location: CONCORD  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF CONCORD  
Name of Highway: LEXINGTON ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Concord

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

LEXINGTON ROAD-EASTBOUND

Beginning at a point 100 feet from Heywood Street  
Thence easterly on Lexington Road  
0.65 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.34 " " 40 " " "  
0.16 " " 35 " " "  
0.62 " " 40 " " " ending at the Lincoln  
Town Line; the total distance being 1.77 miles.

LEXINGTON ROAD-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Lincoln-Concord Town Line  
Thence westerly on Lexington Road  
0.62 miles at 40 miles per hour  
0.16 " " 35 " " "  
0.34 " " 40 " " "  
0.67 " " 35 " " " ending at Heywood Street;  
the total distance being 1.79 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
