In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Cheshire

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

FALES ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Sandmill Road thence northerly on Fales Road:

1.06 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Savoy Road (Rte. 116),

The total distance being 1.06 miles.

FALES ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Savoy Road (Rte 116) thence southerly on Fales Road:

1.06 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Sandmill Road.

The total distance being 1.06 miles.

FRED MASON ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at North Street (Rte 8) thence northerly on Fred Mason Road:

1.11 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the Adams Town Line.

The total distance being 1.11 miles.

FRED MASON ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Adams Town Line thence southerly on Fred Mason Road:

1.11 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at North St. (Rte 8).

The total distance being 1.11 miles.

WEST MT. ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at South St. (Rte 8) thence northerly on West Mt. Road:

1.04 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Lanesborough Mt. Road.

The total distance being 1.04 miles.

WEST MT. ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Lanesborough Mt. Road thence southerly on West Mt. Road: 1.04 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at South St. (Rte 8).

The total distance being 1.04 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
