Name of Highway: County Road

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

heraby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Bourne

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

COUNTY ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 250 feet north of Route 28A

Thence northerly on County Road

0.37 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.08 " " 15 " " "
1.01 " " 25 " " "
1.20 " " 35 " " "
0.29 " " 25 " " "
1.27 " " 35 " " "
0.59 " " 25 " " "
1.39 " " 30 " " "

ending at Shore Road;

the total distance being 6.20 miles.

COUNTY ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Shore Road

Thence southerly on County Road

1.39 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.59 " " 25 " " "
1.27 " " 35 " " "
0.29 " " 25 " " "
1.20 " " 35 " " "
1.01 " " 25 " " "
0.08 " " 15 " " "
0.42 " " 25 " " "

ending at Route 28A;

the total distance being 6.35 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
