Name of Highway: CENTER STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Bellingham

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

CENTER STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning 100 feet north of Pulaski Blvd.
Thence northerly on Center Street
0.35 miles at 40 miles per hour
1.53 " " 45 " " "
0.10 " " 35 " " " ending at South Main Street
(Route 126); the total distance being 1.98 miles.

CENTER STREET-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at South Main Street (Route 126)
Thence southerly on Center Street
1.63 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.30 " " 40 " " "
0.07 " " 35 " " " ending at Pulaski Blvd;
the total distance being 2.00 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
