Highway Location: FALMOUTH  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF FALMOUTH  
Name of Highway: ROUTE 151 - (NATHAN ELLIS HWY.)

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Falmouth

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 151 - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Mashpee-Falmouth Town Line  
Thence westerly on Route 151  
1.07 miles at 50 miles per hour  
0.16 " " 35 " " "  
2.41 " " 50 " " " ending at the beginning  
of State Highway.

Beginning again at end of State Highway  
0.17 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Route 28A;  
the total distance being 3.81 miles.

ROUTE 151 - EASTBOUND

Beginning at Route 28A  
Thence easterly on Route 151  
0.17 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the beginning  
of State Highway.

Beginning again at end of State Highway  
2.41 miles at 50 miles per hour  
0.16 " " 35 " " "  
1.07 " " 50 " " " ending at the Mashpee-  
Falmouth Town Line; the total distance being 3.81 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
