SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 7303-A

Highway Location: LEE  
Authority In Control: COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS  
Name of Highway: ROUTE 20-CENTER STREET-STATE HIGHWAY

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation No. 7303 dated May 10, 1985 is hereby amended in Lee as follows:

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

WESTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

And beginning again in Lee at the beginning of State Highway,  
west of Town at Station 69+32  
Thence westerly 0.10 miles at 20 miles per hour  
0.34 " " 35 " " "

And inserting in place thereof:

And beginning again in Lee at the beginning of State Highway,  
west of Town at Station 69+32:  
Thence westerly in Lee  
0.16 miles at 30 miles per hour  
0.28 " " 35 " " "

EASTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

Thence easterly in Lee  
0.35 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.09 " " 20 " " " to the end of  
State Highway in Lee, west of Town.

And inserting in place thereof:

Thence easterly in Lee  
0.34 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.10 " " 30 " " "

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense, Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly do hereby certify in writing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
