In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Marblehead

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTH STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Washington Street
Thence 0.09 miles at 15 miles per hour ending at the junction of Middle Street.

SOUTH STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Middle Street
Thence 0.09 miles at 15 miles per hour ending at the junction of Washington Street.

MIDDLE STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Washington Street Thence 0.07 miles at 20 miles per hour ending at the junction of South Street.

MIDDLE STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of South Street
Thence 0.07 miles at 20 miles per hour ending at the junction of Washington Street.

LINCOLN AVENUE - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Green Street

Thence 0.28 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Green Street.

LINCOLN AVENUE - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Green Street
Thence 0.28 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Green Street.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
