SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 736-A

Highway Location: MAYNARD
Authority In Control: TOWN OF MAYNARD
Name of Highway: ROUTE 62

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Maynard

Special Speed Regulation number 736 dated October 13, 1972 is hereby amended on Route 62 as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 62-EASTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:
1.17 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.81 " " 35 " " " " ending at the Acton Town

Line.

And inserting in place thereof:
1.32 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.66 " " 35 " " " " ending at the Acton Town

Line.

ROUTE 62-WESTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:
0.81 miles at 35 miles per hour
1.17 " " 25 " " " "

And inserting in place thereof:
0.66 miles at 35 miles per hour
1.32 " " 25 " " " "

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
