In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Maynard

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 27-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Sudbury line,

Thence northerly on Route 27
 1.04 miles at 35 miles per hour
 0.17 " " 20 " " "
 0.52 " " 30 " " "
 0.06 " " 25 " " " ending at Waltham
 Street;

And beginning again at Acton Street,

Thence northerly on Route 27
 0.44 miles at 25 miles per hour
 0.51 " " 30 " " " ending at the
 Acton line; the total distance being 2.74 miles.

ROUTE 27-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Acton line,

Thence southerly on Route 27
 0.51 miles at 30 miles per hour
 0.44 " " 25 " " " ending at Main
 Street;

And beginning again at Parker Street,

Thence southerly on Route 27

0.58 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.17 " " 20 " " "

1.04 " " 35 " " "

ending at the

Sudbury line; the total distance being 2.74 miles.

ROUTE 117-EASTBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet east of Main Street,

Thence easterly on Route 117

0.92 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.21 " " 20 " " "

0.55 " " 35 " " "

ending at the

Sudbury line; the total distance being 1.68 miles.

ROUTE 117-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Sudbury line,

Thence westerly on Route 117

0.55 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.21 " " 20 " " "

0.87 " " 35 " " "

0.08 " " 20 " " "

ending at Main

Street; the total distance being 1.71.

ROUTE 62-EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Stow line,

Thence easterly on Route 62

0.37 miles at 35 miles per hour

~~0.66~~ ~~0.81~~ " " 35 " " "

ending at the

Acton line; the total distance being 2.35 miles.

ROUTE 62-WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Acton line,

Thence westerly on Route 62

~~0.66~~ ~~0.81~~ miles at 35 miles per hour

~~1.32~~ ~~1.17~~ " " 25 " " "

0.37 " " 35 " " "

ending at the

Stow line; the total distance being 2.35 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
