SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 7381

Highway Location: LEE
Authority In Control: TOWN OF LEE
Name of Highway: WOODLAND ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Lee

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

WOODLAND ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Washington Mountain Road
Thence northerly on Woodland Road
0.25 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.40 " " 25 " " "
0.18 " " 20 " " "
0.53 " " 25 " " " ending at Valley Road; the
total distance being 1.36 miles.

WOODLAND ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Valley Road
Thence southerly on Woodland Road
0.53 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.18 " " 20 " " "
0.40 " " 25 " " "
0.25 " " 30 " " " ending at Washington Road;
the total distance being 1.36 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
