SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 7399

Highway Location: GREAT BARRINGTON
Authority In Control: TOWN OF GREAT BARRINGTON
Name of Highway: MAIN STREET (HOUSATONIC)

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Great Barrington

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

MAIN STREET (HOUSATONIC)-EASTBOUND

Beginning at Route 41 (North Plain Road)
Thence easterly on Main Road
0.80 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Route 183;
the total distance being 0.80 miles.

MAIN STREET (HOUSATONIC)-WESTBOUND

Beginning at Route 183
Thence westerly on Main Road
0.80 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Route 41
(North Plain Road); the total distance being 0.80 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
