That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Special Speed Regulation 7421, dated November 18, 1987, is hereby amended on North Main Street as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described.

NORTH MAIN STREET - NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

1.21 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.92 miles at 45 miles per hour ending at the intersection of North Orange Road; the total distance being 4.22 miles.

And inserting in place thereof:

2.13 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the intersection of North Orange Road; the total distance being 4.22 miles.

NORTH MAIN STREET - SOUTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading: Beginning at the intersection of North Orange Road and proceeding southerly;

0.92 miles at 45 miles per hour

1.21 miles at 40 miles per hour

And inserting in place thereof:

Beginning at the intersection of North Orange Road and proceeding southerly;

2.13 miles at 40 miles per hour

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
