Highway Location: ORANGE

Name of Highway (s): EAST MAIN STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Orange

Special Speed Regulation number 7421, dated December 7, 1987 is hereby amended on East Main Street as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

EAST MAIN STREET - EASTBOUND

By striking out the clause reading:

0.28 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the beginning of State Highway; the total distance being 0.50 miles.

And inserting in place thereof:

0.28 miles at 30 miles per hour to the beginning of State Highway.

And beginning again at the junction of Route 2A, where East Main Street and Route 2A diverge, thence easterly, 0.30 miles at 35 miles per hour to the junction of Brookside Road; the total distance being 0.80 miles.

EAST MAIN STREET - WESBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

Beginning at the end of State Highway and proceeding westerly

And

The total distance being 0.50 miles

And inserting in place thereof:

Beginning at the junction of Brookside Road, thence westerly on East Main Street
0.90 miles at 35 miles per hour to the junction of Route 2A, where East Main
Street and Route 2A converge (beginning of State Highway).

And beginning again at the end of State Highway and proceeding westerly

And

The total distance being 0.90 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima
facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90,
Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
