Name of Highway (s): NATICK-STATE HIGHWAY-ROUTE 9

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 7480, dated June 11, 1990, is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Natick and inserting in place hereof the following revisions and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

**NATICK – WESTBOUND**

Thence westerly in Natick

- 0.67 miles at 40 miles per hour
- 2.20 miles at 50 miles per hour
- 0.60 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Framingham Line.

**NATICK – EASTBOUND**

Thence easterly in Natick

- 0.60 miles at 40 miles per hour
- 2.20 miles at 50 miles per hour
- 0.67 miles at 40 miles per hour to the Wellesley line.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.


The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).

The Highway Department and the Registry of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
