 Name of Highway (s): LAKE BUEL ROAD, MONUMENT VALLEY ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
 by the Board of Selectmen
 of the Town of Great Barrington

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

LAKE BUEL ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the New Marlborough Town Line
 Thence northerly on Lake Buel Road
 1.80 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the junction of
 Route 23;

the total distance being 1.80 miles.

LAKE BUEL ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Route 23
 Thence southerly on Lake Buel Road
 1.80 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the New
 Marlborough Town Line;

the total distance being 1.80 miles.

MONUMENT VALLEY ROAD - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at junction of Route 23
Thence northerly on Monument Valley Road
0.20 miles at 35 miles per hour
2.45 miles at 40 miles per hour
1.25 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.50 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.20 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of
Route 7;

the total distance being 4.60 miles.

MONUMENT VALLEY ROAD - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Route 7
Thence southerly on Monument Valley Road
0.20 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.50 miles at 40 miles per hour
1.25 miles at 35 miles per hour
2.45 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.20 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of
Route 23;

the total distance being 4.60 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
