Name of Highway (s): WAPPING ROAD (ROUTE 106)

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Kingston

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

WAPPING ROAD (ROUTE 106) - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Plympton Town Line,
Thence easterly on Wapping Road, (Route 106)
1.46 miles at 45 miles per hour
1.29 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of
Main Street;

the total distance being 2.75 miles.

WAPPING ROAD (ROUTE 106) - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Main Street,
Thence westerly on Wapping Road, (Route 106)
1.29 miles at 35 miles per hour
1.46 miles at 45 miles per hour ending at the Plympton Town
Line;

the total distance being 2.75 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
