SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 755-A

Highway Location: CANTON  
Authority In Control: TOWN OF CANTON  
Name of Highway: CHAPMAN STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Canton

Special Speed Regulation number 755, dated December 26, 1972 is hereby amended by striking out that portion relating to Chapman Street and inserting in place, thereof, the following revision and addenda:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

CHAPMAN STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Neponset Street  
Thence northerly on Chapman Street  
0.74 miles at 30 miles per hour  
0.34 " " 35 " " "  
0.07 " " 25 " " " ending at Washington Street;  
the total distance being 1.15 miles.

CHAPMAN STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 100 feet south of Washington Street  
Thence southerly on Chapman Street  
0.39 miles at 35 miles per hour  
0.74 " " 30 " " " ending at Neponset Street;  
the total distance being 1.13 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
