In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Monterey

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Corashire Road - Northbound

Beginning at the New Marlborough Town Line, thence northerly on Corashire Road

0.40 miles at 35 miles per hour

0.42 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the junction of Route 23, (Main Road); the total distance being 0.82 miles.

Corashire Road - Southbound

Beginning at the junction of Route 23, (Main Road), thence southerly on Corashire Road

0.42 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.40 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the New Marlborough Town Line, the total distance being 0.82 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
