SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION # 7654-B

Highway Location: SALEM

Name of Highway (s): SALEM - STATE HIGHWAY - ROUTE 1A

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

Special Speed Regulation number 7654, dated December 6, 1995, is hereby amended in Salem as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SALEM – NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

Thence northerly in Salem;

0.24 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.40 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.77 miles at 25 miles per hour to the end of State Highway.

And inserting in place thereof:

Thence northerly in Salem;

0.38 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.26 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.77 miles at 30 miles per hour to the end of State Highway.

SALEM – SOUTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading:

And beginning again at the beginning of State Highway in Salem

0.77 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.41 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.21 miles at 30 miles per hour to the Swampscott Town Line.

And inserting in place thereof:

And beginning again at the beginning of State Highway in Salem

0.77 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.26 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.38 miles at 30 miles per hour to the Swampscott Town Line.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).

The Highway Department and the Registry of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
