Name of Highway (s): GOLDSMITH STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Littleton

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

GOLDSMITH STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 1075 feet north of the junction of Newtown Road, thence northerly on Goldsmith Street;
1.19 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of King Street (Route 110/2A); the total distance being 1.19 miles.

GOLDSMITH STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of King Street (Route 110/2A), thence southerly on Goldsmith Street;
1.29 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.10 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Newtown Road; the total distance being 1.39 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
