Name of Highway (s): UPLAND ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted  
by the Director, Traffic and Parking Department  
of the City of Cambridge

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

**UPLAND ROAD - EASTBOUND**

Beginning at the junction of Raymond Street, thence easterly on Upland Road;  
0.39 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Massachusetts Avenue; the total distance being 0.39 miles.

**UPLAND ROAD - WESTBOUND**

Beginning at the junction of Massachusetts Avenue, thence westerly on Upland Road;  
0.57 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Huron Avenue; the total distance being 0.57 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
