Name of Highway (s): SOUTH MAIN STREET (ROUTE 104)

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Raynham

Special Speed Regulation Number 366, dated January 9, 1967 is hereby amended by striking out the Regulation in its entirety and inserting in place the following revisions and addenda.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTH MAIN STREET (ROUTE 104) - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the point 200 feet east of the Taunton City Line, thence easterly on South Main Street (Route 104);

1.44 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of Orchard Street; the total distance being 1.44 miles.

SOUTH MAIN STREET (ROUTE 104) - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Orchard Street, thence westerly on South Main Street (Route 104);

1.48 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Taunton City Line, the total distance being 1.48 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
