Highway Location: DUNSTABLE

Name of Highway: ROUTE 113

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Dunstable

Special Speed Regulation number 778 dated February 7, 1973 is hereby amended by striking out all clauses pertaining to Route 113 and inserting in place thereof the following revision.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 113 - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Pepperell Line
Thence easterly on Route 113
0.38 miles at 25 miles per hour
1.57 " " 45 " " "
0.55 " " 35 " " "
0.82 " " 25 " " "
1.43 " " 30 " " " ending at the Tyngsboro
Town Line; the total distance being 4.75 miles.

ROUTE 113 - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Tyngsboro Line
Thence westerly on Route 113
1.43 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.82 " " 25 " " "
0.55 " " 35 " " "
1.57 " " 45 " " "
0.38 " " 25 " " " ending at the Pepperell
Town Line; the total distance being 4.75 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
