Name of Highway (s): HOWARD STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted  
by the Traffic Commission  
of the City of Melrose

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

HOWARD STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Green Street, thence easterly on Howard Street  
0.66 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the Melrose/Saugus Town Line; the total distance being 0.66 miles.

HOWARD STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Saugus/Melrose City Line, thence westerly on Howard Street  
0.66 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the junction of Green Street; the total distance being 0.66 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
