Name of Highway (s): SEEKONK – SCHOOL STREET
MISCELLANEOUS STATE HIGHWAY

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby promulgated:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SCHOOL STREET – EASTBOUND

Beginning at station 14+95 at the Rhode Island-Massachusetts State Line, thence easterly on School Street

0.54 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of Route 6 (station 43+45); the total distance being 0.54 miles.

SCHOOL STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Route 6 (station 43+45), thence westerly on School Street

0.54 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at station 14+95 at the Massachusetts – Rhode Island State Line; the total distance being 0.54 miles

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).

The Highway Department and the Registry of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
