SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 795

Highway Location: ROCKLAND
Authority in Control: TOWN OF ROCKLAND
Name of Highway: Concord Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Rockland

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Concord Street - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Summer Street,

Thence northerly on Concord Street

0.97 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Market Street; the total distance being 0.97 miles.

Concord Street - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet south of Market Street,

Thence southerly on Concord Street

0.94 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Summer Street; the total distance being 0.94 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
