AUTHORITY IN CONTROL:	DIRECTOR, TRAFFIC & PARKING DEPT.
NAME OF HIGHWAY(S):	WALDEN STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter.Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation to be inserted in Schedule I of the Cambridge Traffic Regulation is

hereby adopted
by the Director of Traffic and Parking
of the City of Cambridge

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

WALDEN STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Vassal Lane,
thence northerly on Walden Street
0.90 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Massachusetts Avenue;
the total being 0.90 miles.

WALDEN STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Massachusetts Avenue,
thence southerly on Walden Street
0.90 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at Vassal Lane; the total
distance being 0.90 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter.Ed.).
