In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Paxton

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Route 56 - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 100 feet north of Route 122,

Thence northerly on Route 56

0.14 miles at 25 miles per hour
1.95 " " 40 " " " ending at the Rutland
Town line; the total distance being 2.09 miles.

Route 56 - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Rutland Town line,

Thence southerly on Route 56

1.95 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.16 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 122; the total distance being 2.11 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
