In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Monterey

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Tyringham Road - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at Route 23,

Thence northerly on Tyringham Road

0.25 miles at 25 miles per hour 0.60 " " 30 " " " " 0.90 " " 35 " " " " 0.50 " " 30 " " "

Town line; the total distance being 2.75 miles.

Tyringham Road - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Tyringham Town line,

Thence southerly on Tyringham Road

0.50 miles at 35 miles per hour 0.50 " " 30 " " " " 0.90 " " 35 " " " " " 0.60 " " 30 " " " " "

0.25 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 23; the total distance being 2.75 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
