Highway Location: TYNGSBOROUGH
Authority In Control: TOWN OF TYNGSBOROUGH
Name of Highway(s): Route 3A

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Tyngsborough

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Route 3-A - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 300 feet north of Route 113
thence northerly on Route 3A.
0.13 miles at 25 miles per hour
1.96 " " 40 " " " " ending at the New Hampshire
State line; the total distance being 2.09 miles.

Route 3-A - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the New Hampshire State line
thence southerly on Route 3A.
1.96 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.19 " " 25 " " " " ending at Route 113;
the total distance being 2.15 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
