Name of Highway: ROUTE 2A

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Greenfield

Special Speed Regulation No. 863 dated April 16, 1974 is hereby amended in Greenfield as follows:

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

HIGH STREET, ROUTE 2A-NORTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading
1.52 miles at 35 miles per hour

And inserting in place thereof
0.77 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.75 " " 35 " " "

HIGH STREET, ROUTE 2A-SOUTHBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading
1.52 miles at 35 miles per hour

And inserting in place thereof
0.75 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.77 " " 30 " " "

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
