SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 871

Highway Location: WEST BRIDGEWATER
Authority in Control: TOWN OF WEST BRIDGEWATER
Name of Highway: Plain Street

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of West Bridgewater

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Plain Street - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the East Bridgewater line,
Thence northerly on Plain Street
0.31 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Brockton
line; the total distance being 0.31 miles.

Plain Street - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the Brockton line,
Thence southerly on Plain Street
0.31 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the East
Bridgewater line; the total distance being 0.31 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
