Highway Location: LAKEVILLE
Authority in Control: TOWN OF LAKEVILLE
Name of Highway: Route 79

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Lakeville

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Route 79 - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Taunton line,

Thence easterly on Route 79

0.34 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.24 " " 25 " " "
0.64 " " 35 " " "
0.83 " " 40 " " "
0.35 " " 30 " " "
0.18 " " 25 " " "
1.62 " " 35 " " "
0.05 " " 25 " " "

ending at the Middleboro

line; the total distance being 4.25 miles.

Route 79 - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Middleboro line,

Thence westerly on Route 79

1.67 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.18 " " 25 " " "
0.35 " " 30 " " "
0.83 " " 40 " " "
0.64 " " 35 " " "
0.24 " " 25 " " "
0.34 " " 40 " " "

ending at the Taunton line

the total distance being 4.25 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
