SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 933-A

Highway Location: READING
Authority In Control: TOWN OF READING
Name of Highway: ROUTE 129

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Reading

Special Speed Regulation numbered 933 dated July 1, 1974 is hereby amended as follows.

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 129 - EASTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading.

Beginning at the Wilmington Town Line
Thence easterly on Route 129
0.51 miles at 40 miles per hour

And inserting in place thereof.

Beginning at the end of State Highway
Thence easterly on Route 129
0.28 miles at 35 miles per hour

ROUTE 129 - WESTBOUND

By striking out the clauses reading
0.51 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the Wilmington
Town Line.

And inserting in place thereof
0.28 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the beginning
of State Highway.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
